AN EC 4			Proposed initial program me of work	TE	ANEC suggests not to exclude the possibility for the new TC to develop home-grown ENs should this be suitable/supported. In our opinion it could be useful to explore the need to develop standards on privacy by design centered on consumer needs. Privacy by design emphasizes technical design embedding consumer protection and control rather than human dependent risk mitigation actions. For example, security updates have to be made regularly. However recent cyberattacks show that consumers are sometimes not very reactive for reasons such as the complexity of the update process. Simplified user controls by design could be helpful. We are currently discussing this proposal at the ISO COPOLCO level and will follow any relevant development.	Add 'ENS' in deliverables to be developed by the new TC.
